## 1 Thessalonians - True Life is Impossible Without God (Part 10) Who will be in Heaven?

When we all get to heaven
Who will be?
The Jehovah's Witnesses say only will get there, everyone else will live on a earth (Rev. 7:1-14)
If 144,000 is literal, what about otherterms?
If one argues that the 144,000 represents a number of literal Israelites, other descriptive terms must be interpreted similarly. (ie. dragon, great whore Babylon, etc)
Pretribulation dispensationalists believe this is literally "Jewish"
If literal, that would mean, according to the Watchtower scheme of interpretation, that would be in heaven who was not of the actual tribes listed.
This would also Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob — who were never of the tribes of Israel. And yet, that with Jesus' affirmation that Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob will be in the kingdom of heaven (Mt. 8:11)
The Mormons say there are levels of Heaven
Celestial– temple Mormons headed toward
Those rejecting the LDS gospel in their mortal lifetimes but accept it in the spirit world and those who falter in beliefs-
Telestial - innumerable multitudes of people who reject the LDS gospel both in mortality and in their afterlife in the spirit world. (Will spend time in outer darkness until end of millennium)
The says many will be in heaven
"many shall come from the east and the west, and shall sit down with Abraham, and Isaac, and Jacob, in the kingdom of heaven" (Mt. 8:11; Rev.7:9-10).
Jesus is the means by which is (John 14:1-7)
Unbelievers will suffer the ultimate of God (Jeremiah 30:23-24; Nahum 1:2-3a; 1 Cor.6:9-11; Rev.21:5-8)
(1 Thess. 4: 16-17) Only born-again believers will spend eternity with Christ
