

2 Thessalonians: Perseverance in Godly Living  
(Part 3) The Antichrist

As apostasy reaches its height in the last days, it finds its representative and \_\_\_\_\_, in “the man of sin”, or” the man of lawlessness.” (2 Thessalonians 2:3)

There are only three passages in the new testament that specifically mention the \_\_\_\_\_,

All in the letters of John (I John 2:18-27, I John 4:1-6, 2 John 7)

Antichrist – “ \_\_\_\_\_ or in opposition to Christ”

The “son of perdition” (KJV) – son of (eternal damnation, utter destruction)

The “abomination of desolation” (detestable one who causes destruction) (Daniel 9:26-27; Matthew 24:15-16)

The book of Revelation describes a singular figure as “the beast from the earth” whose number is 666. (Rev.13:11-18)

He leads worship of \_\_\_\_\_ for the “the beast from the sea” (Revelation 13:1-10)

When Paul says the man of sin, he means the man (2 Thess. 2:3-4)

Not a principle, nor a \_\_\_\_\_, nor a series of persons, but an \_\_\_\_\_ human person who is identified with sin by his very nature
