

Suppressing the Truth and Experiencing Wrath
(Part 2) Choosing Wrath

People who suppress the truth turn to the diametric opposite of truth

The most broken commandments of all (Exodus 20:1-5a)

Idolatry is an attempt to get rid God

Leads to impiety and immorality every time (Romans 1:18-23)

People we know and care about are living under the imminent judgment of God

(Romans 1:19-21) God has revealed himself to man in creation and conscience

Creation is general revelation of God that is both natural and continuous (Psalm 19:1-6)

Makes the reality of God abundantly clear to all of humanity

Does not make salvation plain to us

Special spiritual revelation of God comes through the reality of the cross

It is immediate and specific

Rebellion and atheism are choices that have eternal consequences (2 Corinthians 4:3-4)

People suppress God's truth because they don't want to live with it

God is not indifferent – he is patient, not absent

People who attempt to live a Christian life without realizing the truth of God's wrath set themselves up for failure
