(Hebrews 8:3-5) Jesus made the perfect offering on the cross.

(v.8b-9) God turned his back on Israel and Judah necessitating a new covenant.

(v.10) No stone tablets or circumcision will be required with the new covenant. (2 Corinthians 3:3)

(v.11) All will know God. (1 Corinthians 13:12)
